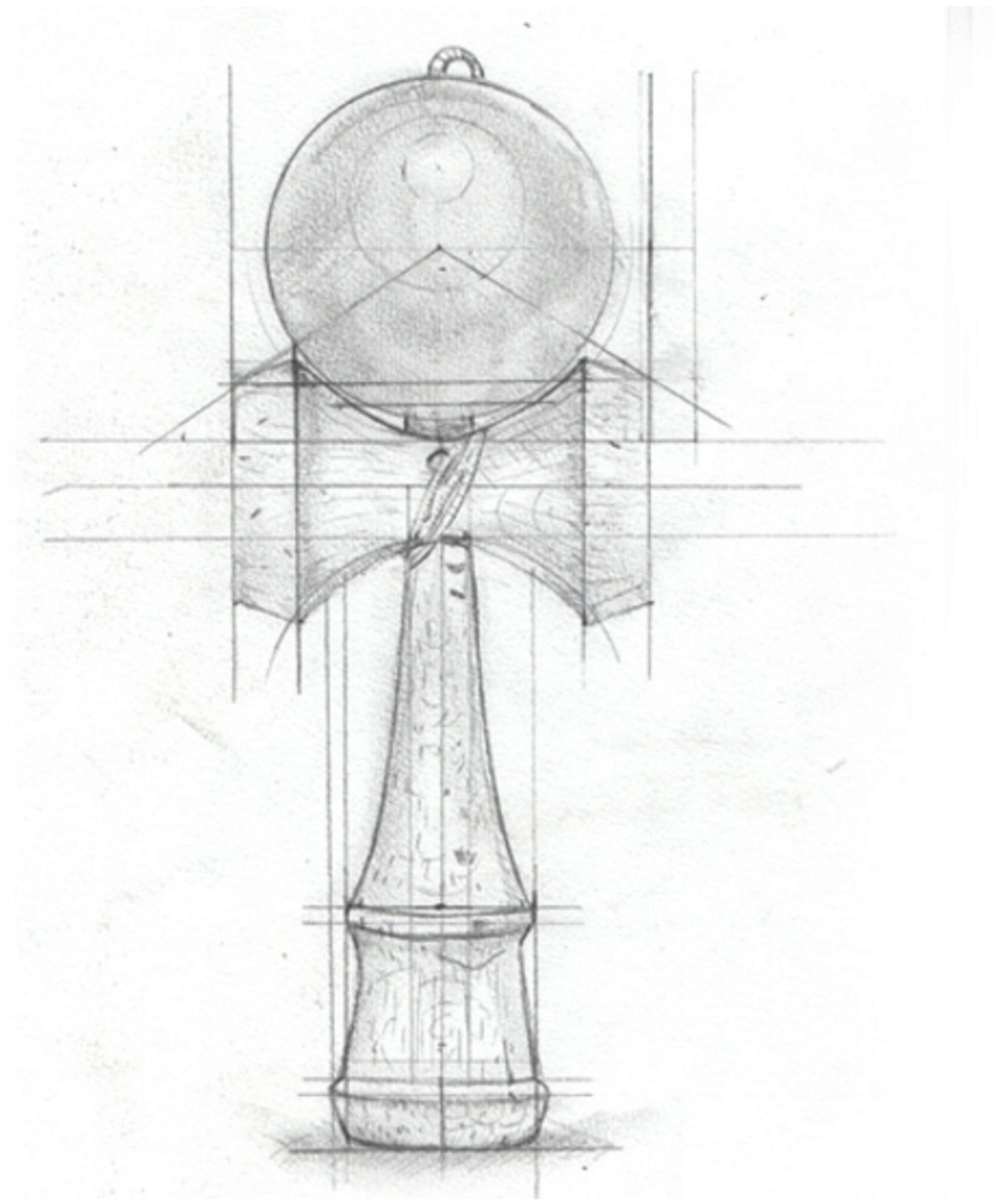
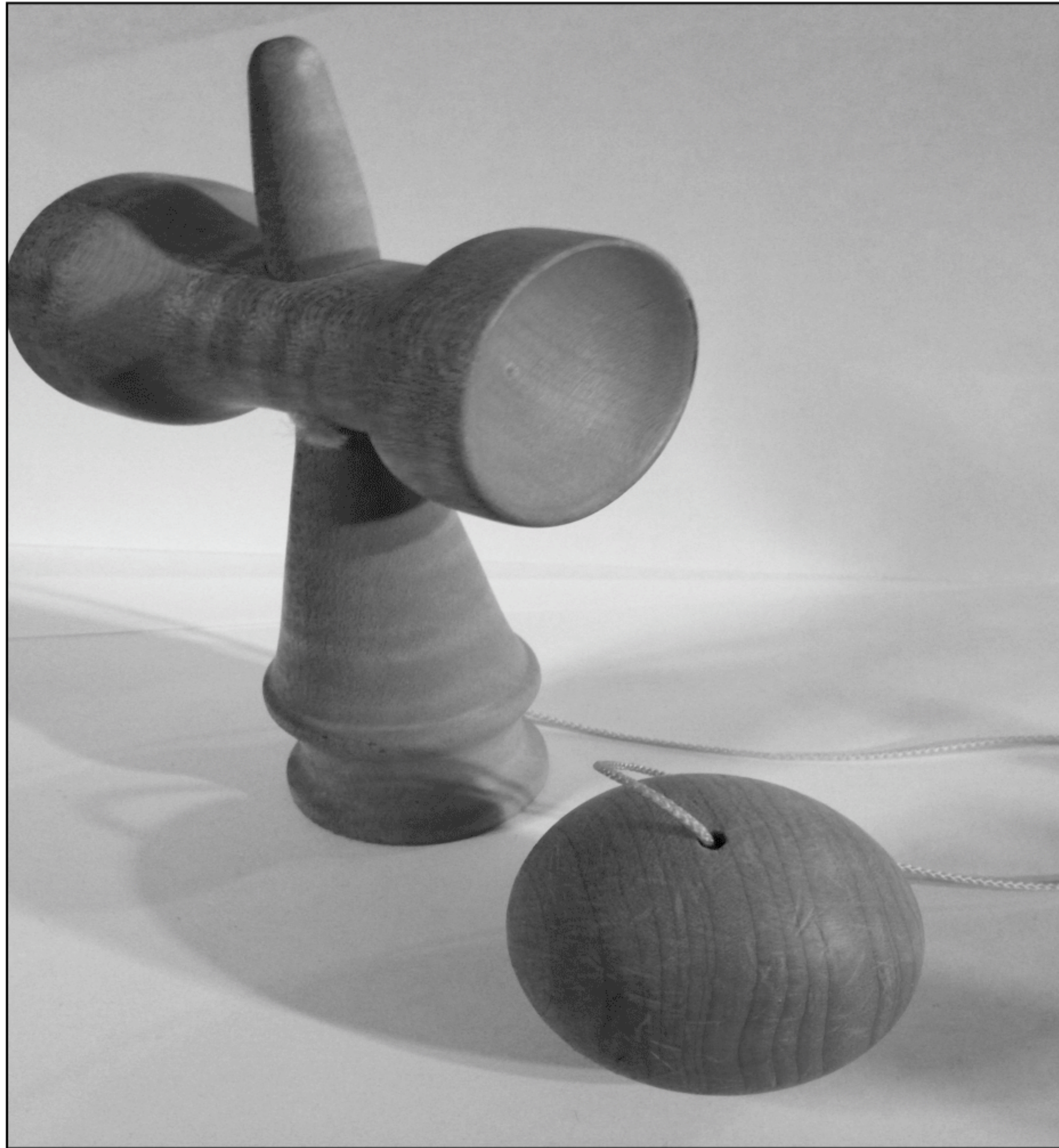


# Kendama

I'm not sure if the Kendama has caught on outside of California, but the ones I made and sold were always enjoyed by everybody.**

**The one I make is 6 1/2" tall. The piece with the 2 cups is 3 1/2" wide and the cup diameter is 2". The ball diameter is 2 1/4" with a 3/4" hole.**
