
Why Phil Typically Uses a Tenon Grip

- Foot should be 1/3 Diameter of Bowl
- Typical Chuck needs minimum 2" Recess
- Add ¼ to ½" around the tenon for strength
- Foot Size is 2-1/2" to 3"
- Bowl must be 7-1/2 to 9" to support this foot size.

 All bets are off if your piece of wood is thick enough to allow for complete removal of the tenon or recess.






Bottom Options



How to Hold a Bowl to Clean up the Bottom

- 1. Longworth Chuck
- 2. Cole Jaws
- 3. Doughnut Chuck
- 4. Vacuum Chuck
- 5. Jam Chuck











Steps in the Process

- Decide on your design
- Chuck your bowl and hold with tail stock
- Take the tenon down to the right size
- Shape your foot
- Sand with tail stock in position
- Take down the nub or cut it off
- Finish sand the bottom
