
Turning and Carving an Ornament






I start with a 2"X2"X4" piece of basswood.





Placed between centers.




Turn a tenon


Turning and Carving an Ornament



Trace the drawing below of the ornament on the wood.



This is a rough drawing of the demeinsion. (actual size)



Turn shape



Drill a 3/8' hole through for the finial

Turning and Carving an Ornament





Remove the tenion using the band saw or carve it off.



Pre-turn finial of your choice and mark the size on the top and botton the blank.



Mark a center line

Turning and Carving an Ornament



Start to carve the nose



Remove the wood on each side of the face.



Pencil in the lines for eyes, cheeks, mustache and lip.

Turning and Carving an Ornament



Carve the cheeks, mustache and lip.



Carve the eyes.



Carve the hat and brim.

Using a small gouge and V-Tool texture mustache.

Turning and Carving an Ornament



Continue to texture the beard and brim of the hat.



After you have completed the carving, scrub carving with hand soap and hot water. Use a finger nail brush. Rinse with hot water.

This removes any dirt and oil from the glove and your hands.



Let the carving dry for 24 hours.

The 3/8" hole will swell from the water, take the drill and pass it throug the hole to open it up.

Turning and Carving an Ornament



After carving is dry, give it a lite coat of Krylon Matte Finish, #1311 spray to seal it.



Useing acrylic paint. Use an eye dropper, 1 drop of paint to about 15 to 20 drops of clean water. Mix well in a plastic palette.

Paints:
Medium flesh
Tomato spice for blush & lips.
Santa Red
White
Medium Blue
Black



After painting is finished, let it dry, and give one more light coat of Krylon #1311

Then antique, using what is available at Michaels or Hobby Lobby.

After painting and antiqueing glue in your finial.
